JOB SUMMARY

This position exists to perform duties that assist the Diner Manager in serving clients in the Fireweed Diner.

ROLE AND RESPONSIBILITIES

Cleaning:

- Daily cleaning of the Diner, Kitchen and Dish areas including sweeping and mopping
- Dishwashing
- · Cleaning all building bathrooms
- Deep cleaning once a month or as assigned
- Weekly cleaning and maintenance of grease trap

Restocking:

- Restocks the Diner and Kitchen areas as instructed
- Restocks all building bathrooms

Other:

- Prepping food
- · Helping volunteers learn and perform their duties for service
- May assist the Diner Manager with the Fireweed Diner's role in special events
- Fireweed Diner opening and closing duties
- Other duties as assigned

- · Maintain client confidentiality
- Maintains food worker card certification
- Maintain DEC kitchen standards

POSITION REQUIREMENTS
